



WetArea Panels Technical Data Sheet & Care Guide

WetArea Panels are made from 10mm rigid PVC with a decorative face. All panels have a tongue and groove long edge

SIZE/WEIGHT: 2400mm x 1000mm x 10mm / 11kg

2200mm x 1000mm x 10mm / 10kg 2700mm x 1000mm x 10mm / 13kg

FIRE & SMOKE RATING:

WetArea Panels carry a Group 1 class, when tested for heat and smoke release in accordance with AS/NZS 3837:1998. The panels have an average specific extinction area of 505m2/kg. No specific fire-fighting instructions are required.

THERMAL PROPERTIES:

WetArea Panels can withstand surface temperatures/heat of up to 60 degrees Celsius before any discolouration or warping of the PVC.

CHEMICAL RESISTANCE:

PVC is resistant to caustics, mineral oil and foodstuffs like milk, coffee etc.

IMPACT RESISTANCE:

Test EN13245-1:2004: Pass: 5 joules at 23 degrees centigrade

SCALE FORMATION:

Low Susceptibility to hard water. Standard scale remover can be used on any scale build up.

CLEANING:

The panels should be cleaned using warm water, a non-abrasive mild detergent (Not Bleach) and a soft cloth. Scouring products or powders should not be used

To ensure the longevity of your WetArea panels, it is essential to follow proper care and maintenance guidelines.

Avoid using abrasive materials or bleach-based cleaning fluids, as they can cause damage to the surface of the panels over time.

Instead, opt for a mild detergent mixed with water and use a soft, non-abrasive cloth for gentle cleaning. This will help preserve the appearance and quality of your panels without causing any harm.
